All Birchtree programs are data-driven and based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis. Board Certified Behavior Analysts train and supervise all instructors.

What is Applied Behavior Analysis?

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is a discipline devoted to the understanding and modification of human behavior. ABA uses methods that are scientifically proven and supported by data to generate change in behaviors. ABA focuses on decreasing maladaptive (challenging) behaviors and increasing adaptive (functional) behaviors.

The Birchtree Center admits students of any sex, race, creed, color, marital status, national/ethnic origin, and economic status. In-Home Services

provide instructional help in the areas of behavior, hygiene, self-help skills, leisure routines, communication, social interaction, community access, academics, and

more. Birchtree's autism experts can offer training to family members and caregivers and help students learn to apply their skills at home and in the community.

Autism Workshops open to the public occur throughout the year. Our autism experts help parents, caregivers, teachers, para-educators, and service providers learn practical strategies for working with students with autism and related disorders.

School/Agency Consultation Services

include consultation and training with a student's educational team; behavioral, educational and individualized program assessments; and the development of interventions and strategies that can be used to strengthen a student's progress in a public school setting.

Birchtree's staff can also provide staff training and supervision; offer in-service workshops; design individualized data-collection systems; and conduct ongoing observations and data analysis to provide recommendations for program modifications.

Individualized Program Evaluations

assess individual students' educational, behavioral and instructional needs and provide recommendations to facilitate skill development and performance across environments.

A Behavior Analyst observes the student and his/her current programming, reviews student records, and interviews staff and family members. A written report summarizes a student's observed behaviors and skills, identifies his/her current level of needs, and makes recommendations for educational and behavioral programming and for the future direction of the student's program and Individualized Education Program (IEP).

Rates: Services are available for an hourly fee plus travel costs (to and from Newington, New Hampshire). Rates vary depending on the type of service offered.

In many cases, services are paid for by a student's school district (for school-based services), developmental agency (for students under 3 years), or health insurance (for some in-home services). To learn more about rates and available services, see birchtreecenter.org/consultation.
