The Birchtree Center for Children was established to provide education and treatment to individuals with autism and other related developmental disorders. The Birchtree Center for Children, first, will open a private, non-profit school program for elementary age children, and second, will expand services to preschool children as well as older individuals. Training of parents, siblings, caregivers and school staff will be an integral part of the program. In th future, The Birchtree Center for Children will extend these services to include support living, work programs, respite care, community education and social services. Each of the activities revolve around education and treatment based upon empirically validated strategies, independent data collection, and evaluation specifically designed for individuals with autism.
